**DEPOSIT:** A deposit of \$300 per person is required to effect reservations and balance of payment is due 60 days before departure.

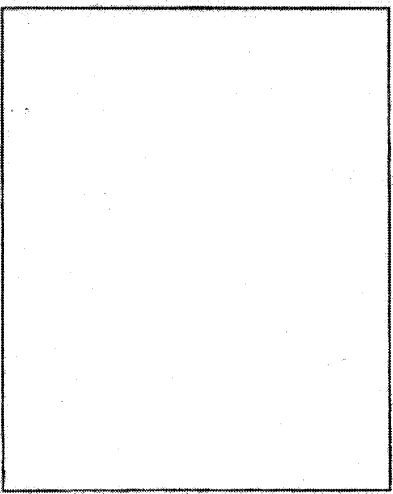

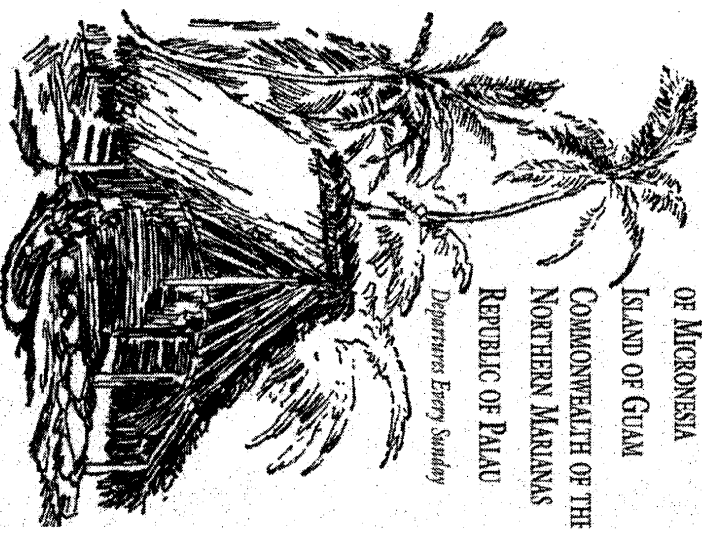

(B) BREAKFAST - (L) LUNCH - (D) DINNER

### SUNDAY / DAY 1

Leave LOS ANGELES in the morning. Arrive HONOLULU in the afternoon. HONOLULU AIRPORT HOTEL.

### MONDAY / DAY 2 (B)

Leave HONOLULU in the morning. Cross date line - lose 1 day.

### TUESDAY / DAY 3

MARSHALL ISLANDS - Arrive MAJURO HOTEL MARSHALL ISLANDS RESORT

Afternoon drive of the town and up the island to Lauer, a scenic village on a magnificent beach. The road to Lauer connects many islets welded together with Navy muscle and mountains of coral.

### WEDNESDAY / DAY 4 (B) - MAJURO FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

Morning free. Leave MAJURO by air. Arrive POHNPEI ISLAND in the afternoon. HOTEL VILLAGE RESORT

### THURSDAY / DAY 5 (B,L) - POHNPEI ISLAND

Full day tour by motor launch to the massive ruins of Nan Madol. This striking and affliging historical landmark is the remnant of a Micronesian Venice with high vaulted walls of basalt rock logs, coral steps and palmways, a Temple of nat Dowry. Excursion dated back to the late 1200's, the ruins of the 100 man-made islands still puzzle archaeologists and engineers who ponder the race which constructed this island city. Picnic lunch included.

### FRIDAY / DAY 6 (B) - POHNPEI ISLAND

Morning visit to downtown Pohnpei. Afternoon free.

### SATURDAY / DAY 7 (B) - POHNPEI ISLAND

Morning free. Leave POHNPEI ISLAND in the afternoon. RUK ISLAND (CHUIK) - Arrive MOEN. HOTEL TRUK BLUE LAGOON RESORT

### SUNDAY / DAY 8 (B) - TRUK (CHUIK)

Morning launch trip on the lagoon. The waters of the vast lagoon are smooth and clear; a star-diver's stream, a water skier's delight and a fisherman's paradise. It is a fact the world's largest lagoon, 350 miles wide. Afternoon drive of the island its own. Enjoy the beaches, visit the Truk Trading Company, part tropical outpost,

part American frontier, and a general store. See remnants of the days when Truk was the Japanese navy's pacific bastion: guns dug into the mountainsides, landing craft resting among the mangroves and on the floor of the Truk lagoon. Imperial Fourth Fleet anchored forever. Also visit the Catholic Mission Church and Xavier High School, a former Japanese communication center.

### MONDAY / DAY 9 (B)

Leave MOEN, TRUK ISLAND in the early morning. GUAM ISLAND arrive AGANA HOTEL GUAM MARRIOTT. Balance of day at leisure.

### TUESDAY / DAY 10 (B)

Leave AGANA by morning flight. NORTHERN MARIANAS arrive SAIPAN HOTEL HAVATT REGENCY. Balance of day free. Optional tours available.

### WEDNESDAY / DAY 11 (B) - SAIPAN

Morning Saipan Island Tour. Saipan was a Japanese city prior to World War II, as evidenced by countless hidden ruins, the Sugar King Park, the old Japanese Hospital and Hall, Tranel Marsh Road along the northwest coastline to Barazi and Saicite Cliffs where - just before the end of the Battle of Saipan - hundreds of Japanese civilians plunged to their death rather than surrender. At the foot of the Saicite Cliff is a natural cave that was the Last Command Post for the defending Japanese forces. Overhead to the rugged eastern shoreline you will find Bird Island. Lookout with a view of the Pacific Ocean that remains with every visitor long after departure. Capral Hill, near the scenic Menat Topographic affords a splendid view of the Philippine Sea, tiny Managaha Island, and vast 15 mile long protective reef, a tropical seas that has lured outsiders to these shores for centuries. Afternoon free.

### THURSDAY / DAY 12 (B) - SAIPAN

Morning free. Leave SAIPAN by afternoon flight. REPUBLIC OF PALAU - Arrive KOROR in the evening. HOTEL PALAU PACIFIC RESORT

### FRIDAY / DAY 13 (B) - KOROR

Morning drive of Koror Island, also called the "Floating Garden Island". Visit the museum and other points of interest. Afternoon free.

### SATURDAY / DAY 14 (B) - KOROR

Day free. Optional Full day Pablu Island.

### SUNDAY / DAY 15 (B)

Leave KOROR by morning flight. YAP ISLAND - Arrive YAP ISLAND.

HOTEL MAANTA BAY BAY Afternoon free.

### MONDAY / DAY 16 (B) - YAP

Morning drive of the island to see Stone Money. While appearing to the visitor to be unattended to and carelessly strewn about, these stones will carry great monetary worth today, as well as prestige and historical value. Lures were low and mounds were spent in quarrying these huge, dome-shaped stones from Palau and Guam, a distance of more than 400 kms. Ranging in size up to 3.60 meters in diameter, Yap's stone money is used as legal tender in traditional business transactions. The largest collection is at the Stone Money Bank near Colonia, the district center. Afternoon free.

### TUESDAY / DAY 17 (B) - YAP

Morning tour to the surrounding areas. Afternoon free.

### WEDNESDAY / DAY 18 (B) - YAP

Morning free. Leave YAP ISLAND in the afternoon. GUAM ISLAND - Arrive AGANA HOTEL GUAM MARRIOTT

### THURSDAY / DAY 19 (B) - GUAM

Morning free. Afternoon Circle Island tour. Panoramic vantage points await every visitor from Two Lovers' Point to the old Spanish Fort of Santa Agueda that overlooks Agaña Bay. In 1736 the first governor's Palace was built in the old capital of Agaña. It now hosts the historic Plaza de España, Chocolate House Museum, Larré Stone Park and Paseo de Susana, Guam's own Senate of Liberty. Southward are now-quiet invasion beaches of Asim and Piti, the scenes of heavy fighting in 1944. Old Fort Soledad, built in 1802 overlooking Umurac Village, watched for Spanish galleons and English prizes. A few miles down the lily coast are Micrzo and spectacular view of Cocons Island at Guam's southern tip, both are popular for picnics and water sports. Inaragan Village still retains its Spanish architecture. Tafelöfen, at Guam's southern end, is famous for its rugged lush jungles; a Japanese straggler hiding out from the war was found there in 1972.

### FRIDAY / DAY 20

Leave GUAM by morning flight. Cross International Date Line - gain 1 day.

### THURSDAY / DAY 19

Arrive HONOLULU in the evening. Leave HONOLULU by evening flight.

### FRIDAY / DAY 20

Arrive LOS ANGELES in the early morning.
